The October 8, 2011 meeting of the NYSQHA was called to order by President Heather DeLucia at 6:30 p.m. at the Sterling Insurance Company, Cobleskill, NY.

Roll call showed the following members present: Heather DeLucia, Diane Tetlak, Ron Bubniak, Amy Bubniak, Kim LaFlair, Eric Dolen, Bruce Emanuel, and Sandi Emanuel. Absent Dee Hartmann, Skip Hartmann, Beckie Thomas, Nicole Thomas and Karen Mault.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Read by President Heather DeLucia. Diane made a motion to accept the secretary's with corrections. Seconded by Kim LaFlair. Vote taken, all in favor, motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Kim LaFlair read the treasurer's report. Beginning balance \$41,822.37. Receipts \$2,929.75, Disbursements \$12,688.63, leaving a balance of \$32,783.49. Amateur account \$390.88. Stallion Service Auction \$14.95. Youth Account \$7471.90. The following bills were presented for payment: \$35.43 reimbursement for bounced checks for the year to Kim LaFlair, \$88.00 for postage for ballots, \$47.35 to Robyn Stultz for printing of flyers.

Diane Tetlak made a motion that the remainder expense money from the Stallion Auction Account be put back in the mother club's account. Ron Bubniak seconded the motion. Vote taken, all in favor, motion carried. Ron Bubniak questioned that on the Show expense report, for the July 5 day, it doesn't show Bruce Emanuel getting paid. Sandi Emanuel asked if we could possibly get money back on our insurance for not having our last show. Diane Tetlak questioned, on the July 5 day, there is a receipt for \$24.50 for hay but we paid \$28. Sandi Emanuel needs the deposit for the Best Western.

Sandi Emanuel motioned to accept the treasurer's report and to pay bills, seconded by Ron Bubniak. Vote taken, all in favor, motion carried. Diane Tetlak made a motion we pay Kim LaFlair her fee for being Treasurer for the year.

COMMUNICATIONS: Heather DeLucia read an email from Kim Emanuel.

Kim Emanuel sent an email requesting we point 2012 EVA Shows and Fair show.

July 29 Cobleskill Fair QH Show DBL pointed

Ron Bubniak made a motion to point the EVA and Fair Shows. Kim LaFlair seconded the motion. Vote taken, all in favor, motion carried. FYI 2013 calendar changes the fair, the show will run on our July 3 day as it stands now, and the fair show has priority. AQHA sends priority dates for two years.

Diane Tetlak read an email from Karen Andrews (Palomino Association) they are holding a meeting on October 30th. Diane told her, if they would want to hold any palomino classes at our show, to email her back.

Ron Bubniak spoke to Leigh Davidson from the Empire Association, he asked if our club would be interested in a trail ride. Leigh Davidson told Ron he would like to see the two clubs do more together.

Eric Dolen reported he spoke to Alice Witheral and she asked about our 8 show rule for points. Heather DeLucia responded there is a 50% rule. (6 shows to qualify).

COMMITTEES:

YOUTH: Lenore Sossei reported Jerry Shupperd is working on the Congress team's jackets. One girl dropped out, and Lenore hopes the team can still compete in the NYAT competition. Diane Tetlak made a motion to give the 3 girls \$500 for expense money.(McKahla Sossei, Ashley Plant, and Madison Frasier). Eric Dolen seconded the motion. Vote taken, all in favor, motion carried. NYAT competition is October 31,2011. Lenore will report on how the girls did at our next meeting.

AMATUER: Kim LaFlair reported the Amateur's will be doing the baskets of cheer, and will have the drawing for the bronze statue at the banquet.

BANQUET: Kim LaFlair will send our deposit to the Best Western for our banquet. Lenore Sossei asked if the youth could have an auction again this year.

FUTURITIES:

CLOSED: Diane Tetlak reported as the closed futurities are done, the money was distributed and the remainder will go to the mother club.

STABLING: Sandi Emanuel asked if we want to do a flat fee or a prepay for stalls. A discussion followed. Sandi Emanuel suggested we get our seasonal stall price set. Kim LaFlair suggested we have Norma Sano send an email stating to 'watch for our seasonal stall rate'. Eric Dolen suggested we push our date back to 1/15/12 or 1/31/12. Show committee will meet.

SHOWS: Ron Bubniak will email Kim Emanuel and let her know to go ahead and hire judges off her list. Sandi Emanuel stated ,for our May show to be an All Novice show, we need to hold a clinic. Ron reported there are trainers out there willing to give free clinics. Sandi Emanuel and Robyn Stultz brought up AQHA new Rookie Program. A discussion followed.

Sandi Emanuel suggested to hold the clinic the night before, to give Kim Emanuel more time before the open show. Also, possibly having more clinics though out the season. A discussion followed. Sandi Emanuel will have Kim Emanuel contact AQHA to find out more about their Rookie Program for our May show. Also, Sandi will have Kim contact Gretchen Mathis to judge our May show and do our clinic. A discussion followed on questions Kim Emanuel had for our show bills for next year, decisions were tabled until next meeting. Sandi brought up personnel for 2012 shows, possibly needing a third ring steward.

Diane Tetlak brought up having someone come in with an embroidering business. The board feels we should check with Jerry Shupperd before making a decision. Diane Tetlak made a motion to have the secretary contact Jerry Shupperd to get her feelings. Kim LaFlair was the second to the motion. Vote taken, all in favor, motion carried.

Sandi Emanuel will contact Herbie Wheeler about being our food vendor for 2012.

Ron Bubniak asked about announcers? Sandi Emanuel will contact Jason Goldberg and Anne Brusoe for announcers. Sandi also has another person interested in being a ring steward along with Jack Goselink. Ron asked for contract proposals from Kim Emanuel, for show secretary and Bruce and Sandi Emanuel for show managers(Sandi will do stabling).

Diane Tetlak motioned to pay our workers \$125 per day, announcers and ring stewards \$175 per day. Ron Bubniak was the second to the motion. Vote taken, all in favor, motion carried.

Diane Tetlak motioned to raise the pay for our treasurer, secretary and point keeper. Eric Dolen was the second to the motion. Vote taken, all in favor, motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: Heather DeLucia reported MaryAnn Morgan suggests we send another letter to the IRS. A Discussion followed. Eric Dolen again suggests we start from scratch. The board agreed to start from scratch. Heather will report back.

NEW BUSINESS: Sandi Emanuel reported on the fairgrounds after the flood, and wanted to thank everyone that came and helped with the work day. They had about 200 volunteers, and reported on all the work that was done. The Hartmann's took our jumps to repair. Ron Bubniak suggested we post a thank you on our website, Eric Dolen suggested adding it to our flyer.(Thank you to the 200 volunteers.) A discussion followed.

Kim LFlair proposed to the board, with the potential for bad weather, to have our January and March meetings on a Saturday or Sunday, in the afternoon. Diane Tetlak thinks the show committee should set up class lists and fees at a separate meeting so as not to take up so much time at our monthly meetings. Then bring to the board for approval.

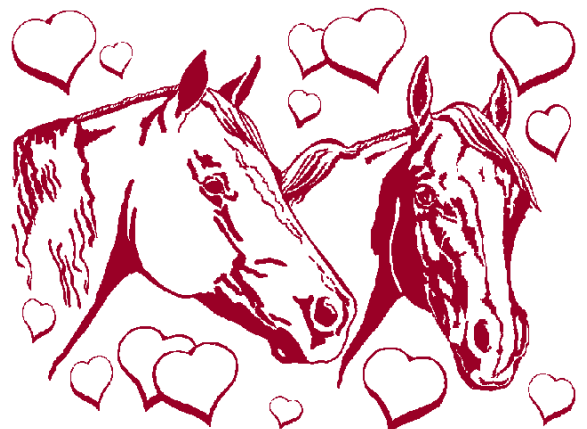

The committee proposed implementing a flat fee for our May show 159, July \$349, August \$279 and September \$159, a \$35 per day stall fee along with the seasonal stall fees of \$325 from now until January 31st, \$350 from February 1st to March 1st, \$400 from March 2nd to April 30th, then \$490 from then on. A discussion followed on all aspects of these fees. Ron Bubniak made a motion that our price for a seasonal stall will be \$325 each from now until January 31, 2012, \$350 from February 1, 2012 to March 1, 2012; \$400 from March 2, 2012 to April 30, 2012. If you want to receive a seasonal stall after April 30, 2012 the cost will be \$490. To receive a seasonal stall, you must be a current 2012 member, and you must call to confirm your stall seven days prior to the start of each show. Bruce Emanuel was the second to the motion. 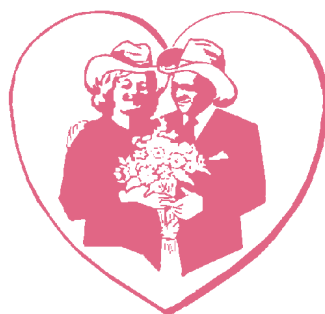
