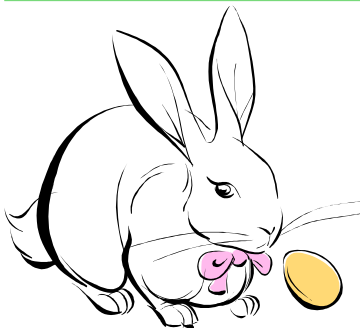

***The candidates must meet the following qualifications:***

*The candidate must be a young lady between the ages of 18 and 25 ( as of January 1, 2011) and be a member of NYSQHA & AQHA.*

*Queen candidates cannot be married, divorced, or a parent.*

*Must complete and submit an application to the NYSQHA Queen Committee Chairperson by March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2011.*

*Must submit a resume which includes a summary of scholastic achievements, activities, personal achievements, future plans and goals.*

***The NYSQHA Queen will have the following duties:***

*Be a positive representative of NYSQHA and the American Quarter Horse industry.*

*Assume a leadership role stressing & exhibiting exemplary sportsmanship at all times.*

*Present awards and help at the Futurity Shows.*

*Attend the Year-End Awards Banquet and help present awards.*

*Represent NYSQHA at the All American Quarter Horse Congress.*

***The Queen candidates will be asked to compete in the following categories:***

***Personal Interview*** - *The personal interview will be held in conjunction with the written test. There will be two or three interviewers, and you will be judged on your answers to their questions as well as your appearance, personality, and overall presentation. (50 %)*

***Written Test*** - *The written test will consist of questions on the 2010 AQHA rulebook, general horse knowledge, and NYSQHA rules. (30%)*

***Horsemanship*** - *If there are more than two candidates a horsemanship class will be held at the Liberty Circuit. (20 %)*

*Should the Queen not abide by the rules as stated herein, neglect her duties, or show lack of responsibility of the Queen title she will be removed from the Queen's position.*

**NEW YORK HELMET LAW:** New York's Vehicle and Traffic Law (Section 1265) and the General Business Law (Section 396-dd) went into effect the first week of January 2000. Section 1265 requires that no person less than fourteen years of age shall ride a horse unless such a person is wearing a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1 163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) Equestrian Standard. Summonses can be issued to a child's parent or guardian for violation of the law. (A copy of the full law is available at the website 111.nyshe.org.)

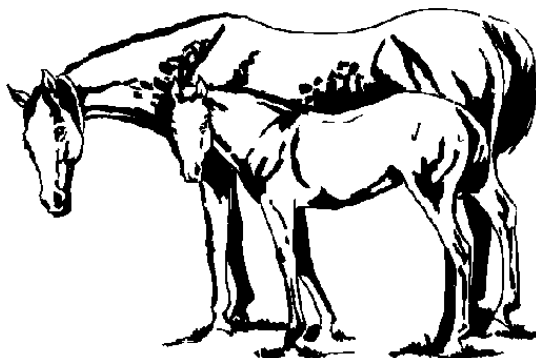

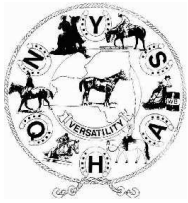

1. NYSQHA Futurities are open to any Quarter Horse registered with AQHA at time of nomination. Both Owners of a Co-Owned horse must have NYSQHA membership. If Owner/Owners are not member(s), membership **must** be received with futurity nomination.
2. If nominated entry is sold, and the new owner/owner(s) are not member(s) of NYSQHA. The Futurity Committee must be notified in writing of the change in ownership of any futurity entry by copy of the signed transfer or registration papers showing new membership. Notification of ownership change will be accepted by telephone, but must be followed up with written confirmation within ten (10) days.
3. A copy of the Breeder's Certificate (for weanlings) or registration papers **MUST** accompany each nomination form as proof of registry with **AQHA**.
4. No refund of entry fees. All entry fees must be payable in US funds. No entry will be shown until all fees are paid in full. U.S. or Canadian postmark determines date of entry.

Second payment postmarked by **7/16/11**      \$50.00

**\*If payment date is missed, the payment is double**

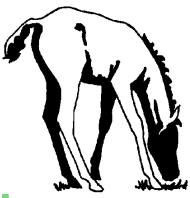
