## Junior Queen's Contest Rules

**The candidates must meet the following qualifications:**

- The candidate must be a young lady between the ages of 14 and 17 ( as of January 1, 2010) and be a member of NYSQHA & AQHA.
- Must be willing to represent the NYSQHA and NYSQHYA at several activities throughout the year
- Must be enthusiastic, responsible, and a good role model for others

**The NYSQHA Junior Queen will have the following duties:**

- Be a positive representative of NYSQHA and the American Quarter Horse industry.
- Assume a leadership role stressing & exhibiting exemplary sportsmanship at all times.
- Help present awards and help at the Futurity Shows.
- Attend the Year-End Awards Banquet and help present awards with the NYSQHA Queen.

**The Junior Queen candidates will be asked to compete in the following categories:**

**Personal Interview** - The personal interview will be held in conjunction with the written test. There will be two or three interviewers, and you will be judged on your answers to their questions as well as your appearance, personality, and overall presentation. (50 %)

**Written Test** - The written test will consist of questions on the 2010 AQHA rulebook, general horse knowledge, and NYSQHA rules. (30%)

**Horsemanship** - If there are more than two candidates a horsemanship class will be held at the Liberty Circuit. (20 %)
